Camper Code of Conduct
2017**

Camp Komaroff is dedicated to providing an outstanding summer camp program. To accomplish this goal, campers are expected to behave in a way that will help promote a safe, fun, and healthy environment that respects our Jewish Camp Values. We ask that all camper and parents/guardians read and sign this code together before arriving at camp.

As a camper, I will:

***Kavod* / RESPECT**

- Be respectful, cooperative, and contribute positively to the experience of fellow campers.
- Be careful and considerate that my actions will not hurt myself or another camper, physically or emotionally, either intentionally or accidentally.
- Show respect to the camp staff and cooperate with their instructions.
- Respect the rights and beliefs of others, and treat others with courtesy and consideration.
 - ~Remember *B'tzelem Elohim*, we are all created in the image of God.
- Respect the property of others, which includes not stealing, inflicting property damage, graffiti, or vandalism.

BEHAVIOR

- Conduct myself responsibly. I understand that horseplay, inappropriate touching, unwelcome teasing/bullying, or other unkind behaviors are not allowed and will not be tolerated.
- Let an adult know if someone is bullying me.
- Let an adult know if I witness someone else being bullied (reporting is confidential).
- Communicate in an appropriate manner, which means I will not use foul language or gestures, harsh words, or raise my voice.
- I understand that pushing, kicking, hitting, or fighting is not acceptable behavior. This kind of behavior will not be tolerated and will be grounds for suspension/dismissal from the camp program.

SAFETY

- Wear closed-toe shoes to camp. I may bring and wear water shoes or flip flops during pool time only.
- Adhere to all safety rules and regulations given for each activity I participate in while at camp.

GENERAL

- Participate in all activities to the best of my ability.
- Not bring weapons, look-alike weapons, or objects that may be used to threaten, intimidate, harm others, or damage property, to camp.

I have read or been read all the above CAMPER'S CODE OF CONDUCT. I agree to adhere to all the above to ensure that my camp experience and the experience of other campers is a positive one. I understand that failure to adhere to these rules may result in my suspension/dismissal from the program.
